The Compton Water Association Board of Directors met on February 13, 2024 at the residence of Board President Roger Jones. After the reading of the minutes, directors report, and bookkeeper report, with no water operator and meter reader present, those reports were not available. John Henderson made a motion to accept the minutes as read. Seconded by Greg Bacarri, motion passed unanimously.

The first order of business was to terminate contract of current water operator and meter reader, Clint Wilt. Motion was made by Greg Bacarri, seconded by Jerry Reagan, motion passed unanimously.

Upon termination of contract with Clint Wilt, Greg Bacarri made a motion to hire JE Blackshear as new water operator to begin immediately, seconded by John Henderson. Motion passed with 4 yeas and 1 nay. Jerry Reagan asked to go one record as being against the hiring of JE Blackshear due to concerns of negative behavior regarding customer service.

The second order of business was the relocation of Compton Water Association truck currently at the residence of Clint Wilt to be relocated by Tim Fletcher to the home of bookkeeper, Ashley Reynolds, for diagnosis of repairs needed. John Henderson made a motion to have the truck moved, seconded by Jerry Reagan. Motion passed unanimously.

Third order of business was the purchase of a new camera to replace current camera belonging to Clint Wilt at the Fire Tower tank. The approximate cost is \$800, giving bookkeeper permission

to purchase camera for up to \$800. Motion made by John Henderson, seconded by Greg Bacarri. Motion passed unanimously.

Next order of business was the removal or possible sale of the Ford pickup located at the pump house. Motion to sell made by Greg Bacarri, seconded by John Henderson. Motion passed unanimously.

Next order of business was the agreement with customer Tim Edgmon that with possible water theft that Compton Water Association would cover ½ of the bill, while he was responsible for the remainder. Motion made by John Henderson, seconded by Jerry Reagan. Motion passed unanimously.

Next order of business was the purchase of a new company laptop and upgrade of QuickBooks due to the age and the possibility of current laptop crashing soon and extremely outdated version of QuickBooks. Motion made by John Henderson, seconded by Greg Bacarri. Motion passed unanimously.

John Henderson made a motion that we return to monthly meetings instead of bi-monthly with meeting time changed from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Motion seconded by Jerry Reagan. Motion passed unanimously.

With no more new business, John Henderson made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by Greg Bacarri. Motion passed unanimously.
